## WNCAP PRODUCES MULTICULTURAL PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS

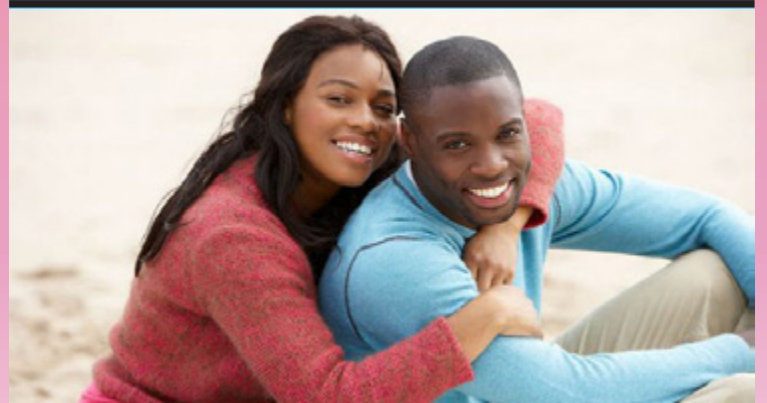
WNCAP is currently in production on a series of public service announcements which will appear on local and regional television channels and social media outlets in the coming months. The televised ads are funded through the North Carolina State Office of Minority Health and Health Disparities and will focus on HIV educational outreach to Latinos and the African-American faith-based community. The public service announcements will address the stigma and misinformation that exist around the subject of HIV and AIDS in our daily lives. "We want to send a positive message that people living with HIV/AIDS need compassion and not judgment", says Brodderick Roary, one of WNCAP's Minority Outreach Case Managers. "The television spots also stress the need for everyone in the community to know their HIV status." The US Center for Disease Control (CDC) states that African-Americans have the most severe burden of HIV of all racial/ethnic groups in the United States. Compared with other races and ethnicities, African Americans account for a higher proportion of new HIV infections, those living with HIV, and those ever diagnosed with AIDS.

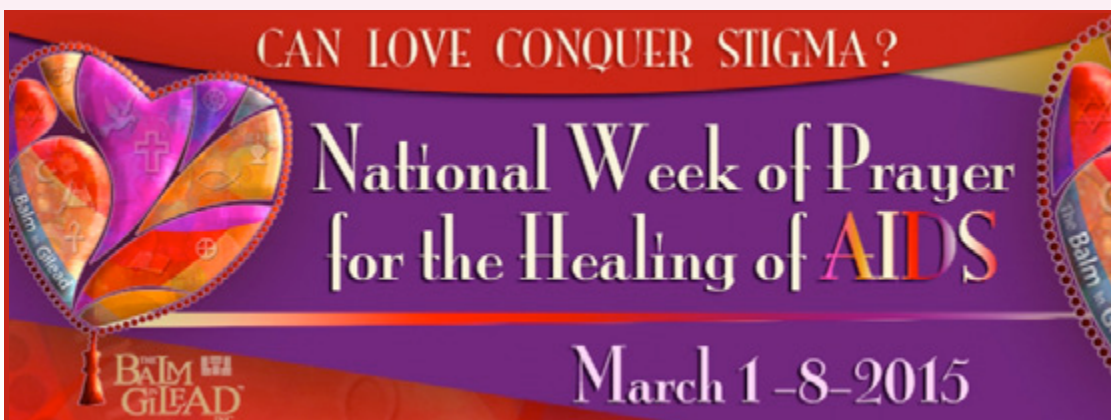

By bringing testing into the community, services can be offered to groups in which HIV and other STDs have been under-diagnosed. WNCAP has hosted free HIV and Hepatitis C testing events at homeless support agencies, health fairs, substance abuse clinics, community centers, churches, colleges, and migrant camps.
