## North Carolina Among Sickest States in U.S.

According to a recent report by the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention ([www.cdc.gov](http://www.cdc.gov)), North Carolina ranks among the most diseased states in the country.

For prevalence in Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs), North Carolina ranks:

- 2nd highest for Gonorrhea infection rates
- 3rd highest for Chlamydia
- 3rd worst overall score
